
Activities to enjoy with your Child at Home



Look in the mirror and identify facial features e.g. eyebrows, eyelashes, cheek, chin.

Explore a variety of fruit and vegetables with your child for example colour, shape, texture. Model vocabulary such as smooth, rough, shiny, hard, soft.

Allow your child to develop new skills such as butter bread, grate/cut cheese.

Empty and Full

Play in the kitchen sink or bath provides wonderful opportunity to develop language related to capacity. All you need are a variety of containers e.g., plastic bottles, cups, jugs and bowls. Allow your child to engage in exploratory play and to fill/empty containers. Comment on your child's play and emphasise key vocabulary e.g. 'The bottle is so full. Now it is empty.'
